

Board Meeting Agreed Report - 19th September, 2023

Principal's Report:

A temporary teacher nominee, Ann Marie Greene, was welcomed to the Board.

The Board was updated on various student activities including the TY outdoor pursuits trip to Petersburg, ongoing rehearsals for our school musical, Back to the 80s and U16/U19 basketball matches. The extra-curricular schedule is up and running, with a range of clubs and activities taking place on Tuesday and Thursday evenings, as well as lunchtimes.

The Student Council has been elected and two members will join the Board in due course.

Staff CPD to date included SSE training with Oide and CPD in History and Computer Science. One of our SETs attended this year's JMB conference on Special Classes.

The first meeting of the Parents' & Guardians' Community will take place in the coming weeks. Parents who generously sponsored sports' kits were thanked by the Board, as were members of the PCG who organised a gofundme to raise further funds.

Work is ongoing on our bid to become a School of Sanctuary, with a meeting scheduled next week. New staff members will receive CPD on GCE from Educate Together, as will staff who are rolling out Ethical Education at Senior Cycles. Black History Month will take place in October.
